## Trinidad and Tobago COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) Update #481

**Port-of-Spain, September 25, 2020:** As part of the national drive to safeguard the health of the Trinidad and Tobago population in the face of the global COVID-19 outbreak, the Ministry of Health continues to provide up-to-date information on the country's status. The population is reminded to rely on information from official sources only, such as the Ministry of Health.

As of the alternoon of Finday 25 September, 2020 the Ministry	reports the following.

Number of samples which have tested positive at public and private facilities in Trinidad and Tobago	4,277
Total number of active cases	2,085

As of the **afternoon** of **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September**, **2020** the Ministry reports the following:

The Ministry of Health provides the following update:

- Seventeen (17) additional persons have tested positive for COVID-19. •
- The Ministry of Health regrets to inform the public that there has been an additional COVID-19 related death. The person is an elderly male with comorbidities. This brings the total number of COVID-19 related deaths to 70.
