The Ministry of Health provides the following update:

- 43 additional persons have tested positive for COVID -19
  These new 43 new patients will be processed for admission at the discretion of the CMOHs.
- 12 persons have been discharged from public health facilities
- 88 are recovered community cases
  Recovered community cases refer to persons who were previously COVID-19 positive
  and in self-isolation at home and subsequently met the discharge criteria and were
  released from self-isolation.
