Total persons Vaccinated with 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose of a Two Dose Regime: **431,899**

Total Persons Vaccinated Under a Single Dose Regime: **9,641**

Total Persons with a Completed Vaccination Regime: **441,540**

\*Of the total number of persons tested, 139,782 were done at private facilities.

\* A person is considered to be **fully vaccinated** 2 weeks after receiving the final recommended vaccine dose(s) of a World Health Organisation (WHO) approved vaccine or vaccine combination.
